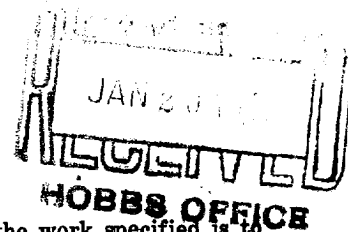

Propose to drill plug and test shut-off at 11 PM January 18, 1948.
