Arch Petroleum, Inc. respectfully request administrative approval for a non-standard Blinebry Gas Proration Unit for the W. A. Rinewalt No. 2 well.

Arch Petroleum, Inc. is planning to add perfs to the Blinebry Gas zone in this existing Blinebry Oil completion and abandon the Drinkard completion in the W. A. Rinewalt No. 2 well. The location of the proposed recompletion is 1874 feet FNL and 750 feet FWL of section 4, T22S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico. This well is currently down hole commingled with the Drinkard and will become a non-standard Blinebry gas well location, as it is only 554 feet from the north lease line and 570 feet from the east lease line.

The proposed non-standard gas proration unit would consist of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 4, T22S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Attached is a C102 identifying the proposed proration unit, a commercial map, a list of the offset operators, and a copy of the certified letter sent to the offset operators.
