Gentlemen:

Please consider this application for administrative approval of a 120-acre nonstandard Tubb gas proration unit to be dedicated to Shell Rinewalt 4. As shown on the attached plat, Rinewalt 4 is located 760 feet from the north line and 1980 feet from the west line of Section 4, Township 22-south, Range 37-east, Lea County, New Mexico.

The proposed nonstandard gas unit will comprise the east half and the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 4 as outlined in red on the plat. This same Tubb gas unit is dedicated to Shell Rinewalt 2, a twin well to Rinewalt 4. The Tubb gas drainage point was moved from Rinewalt 2 to Rinewalt 4 and is the reason for requesting the proposed gas unit.

Rinewalt 4 is now dually completed in the Tubb gas and Wantz Abo oil pools. A diagrammatic sketch showing the dual completion is attached for your files. This dual completion was approved by N.M.O.C.C. Administrative Order MC-1625. The Tubb calculated open flow potential was measured at 1170 MCF per day and the Abo potentialled for 96 BOPD. All offset operators have been furnished copies of this application.
