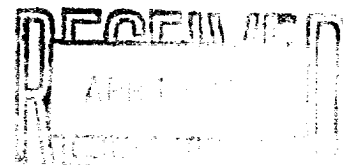

REASON FOR DOING WORK:

Well, before deepening, would produce only 1 to 2 bbls. oil per day and due to deeper offset obligations was necessary that well be drilled to deeper pay horizon on the 40-acre tract on which this well is located.

CONTRACTOR: Coats & Foster Drilling Co., Lubbock, Texas, (Rotary)

Started rigging up rotary tools on January 30, 1948, and on February 2, 1948 corrected total depth from 3721 to 3732 by Rotary Table measurement, and mixed jelly flake and circulated hole preparatory to drilling deeper from old total depth of 3732'.

Ran and cemented string of 5" OD casing at 6580' w/ 220 sacks. Drilled cement out of 5" casing to 6577' and tested casing OK.

Perforated 5" OD casing from 6520' to 6565' with 5 shots per foot.

Ran 2" EUE tubing and displaced mud with water and water with oil, set tubing at 6574' with perforation on bottom and 5" x 2" Guiberson Packer at 6200'.

Swabbed hole down before treating. Well showed very small amount of gas, and swabbed at the rate of 2 bbls. oil per day.

Acidized with total of 4500 gallons acid and well completed for IP of 86 bbls. oil in 24 hrs. thru 18/64" choke and GOR 1273/1.
