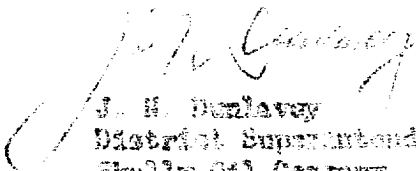
Enclosed is a revised application for administrative approval to
dual complete our E. A. Sticher Well No. 4 in the Tubb and Blinebry
Gas Pools.

The original application, which was approved on March 14, 1960,
stated that the Tubb zone would be produced through tubing while the
Blinebry zone would be produced through the casing-tubing annulus.
However, after testing we have concluded that the Blinebry gas zone
cannot be efficiently produced through the casing-tubing annulus.

Since your letter of March 14, 1960 indicated that Administrative
Order 90 914 would be applicable only to an annular type completion
for the Blinebry, it is requested that an order be issued which would
allow us to utilize two strings of tubing, one to produce the Tubb gas
and one to produce the Blinebry gas.

Your consideration in this matter will be appreciated.
