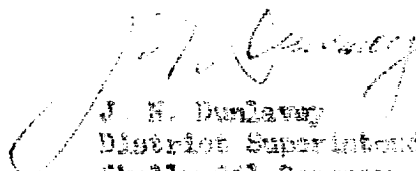
Enclosed is a revised application for administrative approval to
complete our E. A. Sticher Well No. 4 in the Tubb and Blinbry
Gas Pools.

The original application, which was approved on March 14, 1960,
stated that the Tubb zone would be produced through tubing while the
Blinbry zone would be produced through the casing-tubing annulus.
However, after testing we have concluded that the Blinbry gas zone
cannot be efficiently produced through the casing-tubing annulus.

Since your letter of March 14, 1960 indicated that Administra-
tive Order 80-914 would be applicable only to an annular type completion
for the Blinbry, it is requested that an order be issued which would
allow us to utilize two strings of tubing, one to produce the Tubb gas
and one to produce the Blinbry gas.

Your consideration in this matter will be appreciated.
