DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well was spudded on August 24, 1937, and hole drilled to 306 feet.
 304 feet of 7 5/8" 26 lb. pipe was set. Heavy mud was circulated ahead
 of cement and 170 sacks of cement were run, getting circulation of cement
 in the cellar. After 24 hrs. pipe was tested with pressure and found to
 be satisfactory. After 36 hrs. plug was drilled and hole bailed dry for
 a shut off test and found to be satisfactory. Drilling was then continued.
