AMENDED COMMINGLING ORDER PLC-131

The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle Penrose Skelly Grayburg (Oil - 50350), Drinkard (Oil - 19190), Blinebry Oil & Gas (Oil - 6660), and Tubb Oil & Gas (Oil - 60240) Pool production from the following leases:

Lease: Rinewalt "A" Well No. 1  
Description: NW/4 of Section 4, and,

Lease: Rinewalt Well No. 1  
Description: NW/4 of Section 4,

Lease: Rinewalt "B" Well No. 1  
Description: NW/4 of Section 4,

all in Township 22 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Production will be allocated to each lease by monthly well tests. Multiple pool production from the Rinewalt "B" Well No. 1 will also be allocated by well tests. This method is authorized only so long as all production is of identical ownership including working interest, royalty interest and overriding royalty interest.

FURTHER: The operator will notify the Hobbs District Office of the Division upon implementation of the commingling process.

REMARKS: This installation will be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 309-B of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.


NOTE: The commingled production will be stored in the Rinewalt tank battery facility located in the NW/4 of section 4, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
