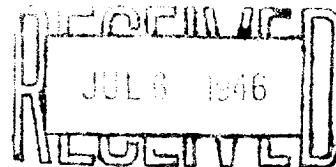

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Set 9-5/8" OD casing at 3,000', cemented with 1,500 sacks cement. 1,000# pressure was pumped on casing before and after drilling plug and maintained for 30 minutes; a satisfactory shutoff was obtained.
