

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Set 5½" OD 17# casing at 8,097', and cemented with 150 sacks, ran temperature survey and cement was located at 7,520'; perforated with two 1½" shots at 7512' and cemented with 1,200 sacks.

Casing was tested with 1,650# pressure before and after drilling out cement and allowed to stand for 30 minutes to check for pressure decline, held ok.
