FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Well was completed 8/6/37 at a total depth of 3780' by Landreth Production Company and was potentialized at 300 BOPD after acidizing with 3000 gallons acid. Production has now declined to two BOPD.

We propose to temporarily abandon this well by pulling tubing and pump and equipping the surface head of the 7" casing with a swage nipple and gate valve. The valve will be closed and bull plugged to protect the hole until further work or permanent abandonment is undertaken.
