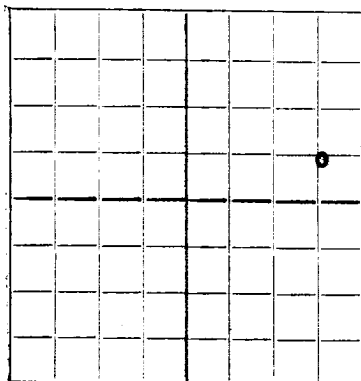

We propose to fill hole with drilling mud when cementing 8", and after pulling 10" and 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " run 160' of 40# 10 thread S H 10" and cement same thru 2" ~~back to 140'~~ from 140' back to bottom of cellar, then pull 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
