Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising N/2 of NE/4 of Section 5, T-22-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as its Lee Stebbins "B" Lease, Lea County, New Mexico, as shown on the attached plat.
- (2) Gulf Oil Corporation proposes that the above described acreage be established as a non-standard 80-acre gas proration unit in exception to Rule 5 (a) of Order R-586.
- (3) The Lee Stebbins "B" Well No. 3, located 660 feet from the North line and 460 feet from the East line of Section 5, T-22-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico was originally completed May 24, 1947, as an oil well in the Drinkard Oil Pool and was dually completed January 8, 1957, as a gas well in the Tubb Gas Pool. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
- (4) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5 (b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-586 as follows:
 - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.

of a non-standard gas provision unit comprising 8 1/2 of 8 1/4 of Section
2, T-22-S, R-37-E, Cass County, New Mexico, and in support thereof
states the following facts:

(1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of an
oil and gas lease known as the "Stabbing" #1
lease, Cass County, New Mexico, as shown on the
attached map.

(2) Gulf Oil Corporation proposes that the above
described acreage be established as a non-standard
80-acre gas provision unit in exception to Rule
2 (a) of Order A-266.

(3) The "Stabbing" #1 well No. 1, located 600 feet
from the north line and 400 feet from the east line
of Section 2, T-22-S, R-37-E, Cass County, New Mexico
was originally completed May 24, 1937, as an oil
well in the Brinkard Oil Pool and was finally com-
pleted January 2, 1937, as a gas well in the Webb
Gas Pool. The applicant proposes to use this well
as the well.

(4) The proposed non-standard gas provision unit will
meet the requirements of Rule 2 (b) of the Oil
Conservation Commission Order No. A-266 as follows:

(a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections
will comprise the unit.
