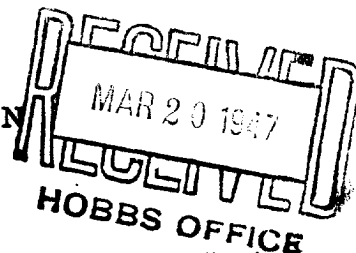

## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On March 17, 1947 the 13-5/8" OD 48# 8 rrd thd NY new A. O. Smith casing was set in the Red Bed at 295'. Cemented with 300 sacks Trinity neat bulk cement by Halliburton method. Plug to 275' and cement circulated OK. Job started at 6:30 PM and completed 11:30 PM March 17, 1947.

Propose to drill plug and test shut-off at 11:30 AM March 19, 1947.
