FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well has been producing from Penrose-Skelly formation since June 1, 1937. The initial production test was 140 bbls. per day. In November 1938 well was drilled deeper to 3765'. After acidizing w/2000 gals. well produced 192 bbls. per day thru 9 flow valves. At present well is producing 1 bbl. per day.

Following is a record of casing in the well:

13-3/8" set @ 275'.
8-5/8" set @ 1237'.
7" set @ 3510'.

It is The Ohio Oil Company's intention to drill this well deeper to test the Drinkard Zone. Will case and cement off old pay zone from 3687 to 3765. Rotary tools will be used from present depth to approximately 6500. Approximately 3500 of 5 1/2" on top which will be run inside of old 7" casing. 5" extreme line will be used from 3500 to approximately 6500 and cemented to surface.
