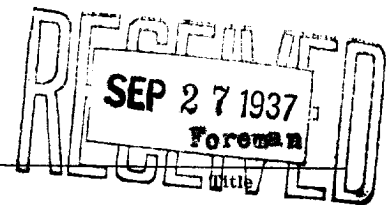

NOTES ON THE ETHNOLOGY OF THE
NORTH-WEST COAST OF AFRICA

The following notes are based on the collection of ethnographic material made by the late Mr. J. H. R. Taylor, F.R.S., during his travels in the north-west coast of Africa, and are published by permission of the Trustees of the British Museum.

THE ETHNOLOGY OF THE NORTH-WEST COAST OF AFRICA

The north-west coast of Africa is a region of great ethnographic interest, and the collection of material made by Mr. Taylor is one of the most valuable ever made in this region.

The collection is now deposited in the British Museum, and is open to the public.

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
