Neville G. Penrose, Inc. hereby makes application for administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the S/2 of the NE/4 of Section 5, T-22-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and, in support thereof, states the following facts:

2. Neville G. Penrose, Inc. proposes that the above described acreage be established as a non-standard 80-acre gas proration unit in exception of Rule 5 of Oil Conservation Commission Order R-586.

3. The Grizzell #1 well, located 1760' from the North and East lines of section 5, T-22-S, R-37-E, was completed as a Drinkard oil well on November 13, 1950. We propose to dually complete this well in the Drinkard and Tubbs zones. (Application for dual completion accompanies this application for non-standard unit).

Mobile Oil Company, Inc. hereby makes application for
recognition and approval of a non-standard gas production unit
comprising the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 5, T-22-N, R-37-E,
Lea County, New Mexico, and, in support thereof, states the
following facts:

1. Mobile Oil Company, Inc. is owner and operator
of the oil and gas leases known as the Grissell (SW 1/4 of NW 1/4,
Section 5) and Christmas Cowden (SW 1/4 of NW 1/4, Section 5) leases.

2. Mobile Oil Company, Inc. proposes that the above
described acreage be established as a non-standard 80-acre gas
production unit in execution of rule 2 of Oil Conservation Com-
mission Order 9-586.

3. The Grissell oil well, located 1500' from the North
and East lines of Section 5, T-22-N, R-37-E, was completed as a
frank oil well on November 15, 1950. We propose to finally
complete this well in the Grissell and Tubbs zones. (Application
for gas production completes this application for non-standard
unit).

4. The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5 of Oil Conservation Commission Order R-586 as follows:

- a. Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
- b. The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- c. All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.
- d. The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 2640'.
- e. Neville G. Penrose, Inc. is operator of all acreage comprising the proposed unit as shown on the attached plat, and by copy of this letter of application, all operators owning an interest within this section and all operators within 1500' of the proposed unit well are notified of the intent of Neville G. Penrose, Inc. to form the proposed non-standard gas proration unit.


5. The approval of this application for the 80-acre non-standard gas proration unit will, in the opinion of the applicant, prevent waste, protect correlative rights and serve the best interest of conservation.

In view of the existence of the facts herein stated and in compliance with the provisions of Rule 5 of the Oil

Investigation Commission's Order R-558, Noville C. Pearson,
and respectfully requests that the Secretary of the Com-
mission approve the above described non-standard gas flow
