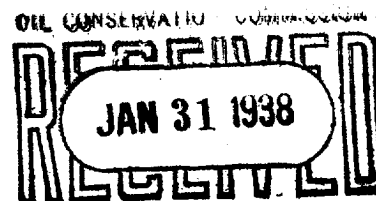

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Before shot the production in this well had decreased to 35 barrels of oil per day. On January 21, 1938, the well was shot with 330 qts. of nitroglycerin from 3665 to 3786. The well was cleaned out and tested and made 113 barrels of oil in 12 hrs. and was flowing at the rate of 10 barrels per hour at the end of the 24 hour period.

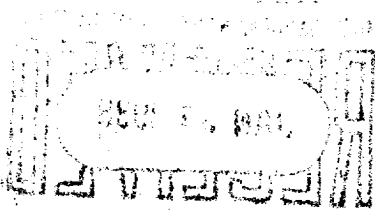
