DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On June 2, 1951, 36 hours after cementing the 5" liner from 3400' to 6495' with 250 sacks 8% gel cement and 50 sax Neat cement, liner was tested with 1150 psi for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure occurred. Plug at top of liner was then drilled and liner was tested with 1200 psi for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure occurred. Tests were considered satisfactory and operations were resumed.
