Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising E/2 of SW/4 of Section 6, T-22-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as its H. T. Mattern "D" Lease, Lea County, New Mexico, as shown on the attached plat.
- (2) Gulf Oil Corporation proposes that the above described acreage be established as a non-standard 80-acre gas proration unit in exception to Rule 5 (a) of Order R-520.
- (3) The H. T. Mattern "D" Well No. 6, located 1980 feet from the West line and 660 feet from the South line of Section 6, T-22-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, was completed January 3, 1957, as a gas well in the Eumont Gas Pool. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
- (4) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5 (b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
 - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.

The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.

(4) The proposed non-standard gas production unit will meet
the requirements of Rule 8 (b) of the Oil Conservation
Commission Order 1-520 as follows:

(a) The proposed unit will be a gas production unit
comprising the well.
