Since your Downes Well No. 3 located in Unit B of Section 6, T-22-S, R-37-E, is producing with a ratio in excess of 100,000 to 1, it is being reclassified as a gas well in the Eumont Gas Pool effective May 1, 1972.

The well is to be shut in on that date and is to remain shut in until you have complied with the provisions of Commission Order No. R-1670 pertaining to the Eumont Gas Pool.
