
We hereby submit application and request administrative approval under the provisions of Statewide Rule 104, Section F for an exception to the well location requirement of Section C, Rule 104. This exception is for our Grizzell No. 6, located 2220 feet from the south line and 420 feet from the east line of Section 8, T-22-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The unorthodox location of our Grizzell No. 6 in the Blinebry Gas Pool resulted when the well was recompleted from the Drinkard Oil Pool to the Blinebry. This well was originally drilled on an orthodox Drinkard oil well location.

A plat is attached showing the location of well No. 6 within its gas proration unit, the location of other wells on the lease, and offset wells and ownership thereof.
