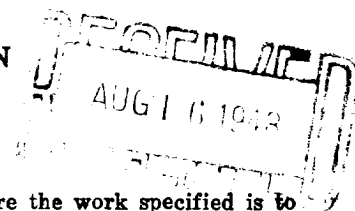

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

To deepen well from 3767 to 6550 feet and recompleat as a Drinkard Pool well. A 5" liner will be set to new total depth and stage cemented from total depth to approximately 100 feet above and inside the shoe of the 7" casing now set and cemented at 3547 feet. The 5" liner will be perforated opposite the Drinkard pay and the formation may be treated with approximately 3000 gallons of acid.
