DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Treated well with 2,000 gallons of Halliburton acid in lime formation from 3615' to 3705'. Flushed with 23 bbls. oil. Swabbed well in - well flowed short time & died due to heavy load of oil. Swabbed well in - started flowing. Let well clean itself several days. Flowed 62 bbls. fluid in 24 hour test through 1/2" choke. 1.5% acid sludge. Gas-oil ratio 5.1.
