Gentlemen:

Humble Oil & Refining Company respectfully requests administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit of 160 acres in the Eumont Gas Pool, being the N/2 of the S/2 of Section 9, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. This unit is to be assigned to Humble's J. L. Greenwood Well No. 5, located 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line of Section 9, Range 37 East. In support of this request, we submit the following information:

1. J. L. Greenwood Well No. 5 was a water injection well in the Penrose Skelly water flood area until the project was discontinued on August 31, 1956. The water injection zone was plugged off and the well recompleted in the Eumont Gas Zone.
2. The proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
3. The non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
4. The entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
5. The length or width of the non-standard gas proration unit does not exceed 5280 feet.
6. All operators owning interests in this section and offset operators have been furnished copies of this application by Certified Mail.
7. Copies of Form C-128, Gas Well Plats and Lease Plats showing pertinent lease information are attached.

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
