Gentlemen:

We recently received a gas disconnect notice for the Blinebry Pool for your J. L. Greenwood #11 from El Paso Natural Gas.

This well is a downhole commingled Blinebry and Drinkard as authroized by DHC-593. Since the Blinebry zone was classified as gas when the well was downhole commingled it should remain gas. Therefore, I do not see why we received a disconnect for the Blinebry since you are currently reporting production from both zones on your C-115.

It is the operator's responsibility to advise the transporter of the commingling authority and to make certain the transporter reports the gas takes (on his C-111) according to the percentages set out in the DHC order for a prorated gas zone. This is the only way the gas production for the gas allowable schedule can be picked up.

Please advise status of this well.
