DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Treated perforations in 5 1/2" casing from 7466' to 7492' with 500 gallons of acid. Swabbed tubing dry with slight show of oil and gas. Treated 2nd stage with 2000 gallons of acid. Swabbed out acid with water and well swabbed dry showing little gas and approximately 1/2 bbl of oil per hour. Treated with 6000 gallons of acid. While swabbing from bottom, well made 3 bbls of acid water with oil stain on 4 hour test.
