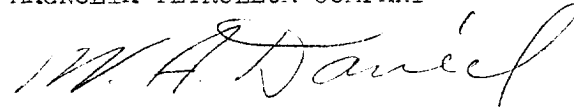
As required by New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission's Rule No. 112-A and orders R-372A and R-373A, we attach hereto the following data:
