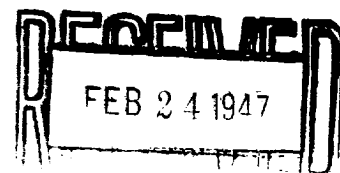

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well has been producing from the Penrose-Skelly Field formation, since May 29, 1938. The initial production is 300 bbls. of oil per day. The present production is 8 bbls. of oil per day and no water.

Following is a record of casing in well:

13-3/8" OD 54# Seamless, set @ 62' 6" with 30 sack cement.

9-5/8" OD 34# Seamless, set @ 1391' with 300 sack cement.

7" OD 24# Seamless, set @ 3630' with 150 sack cement.

It is the Magnolia's intention to drill this well deeper to the Drinkard Pay Zone. A Caliper Survey will be made, and if necessary, the shot hole will be cemented. Rotary tools will be used to drill a 6-3/4" hole from the present total depth of 3738' to approximately 6650'. 5" OD casing will be set on bottom w/250 sack of cement and perforated opposite the producing zone.
