Perf 6450-6540 was acidized with 5000 Gallons 15% TP 500 - 2250 - 1700 - 1200 - 1400; Oil Flush 1400-500; CP 250 - 500; 1 hour & 2 minutes 5.6 barrels per minute; Test after treatment flowed 25.69 barrels of oil in 8 hours; 3/4" choke; GOR 1705-1; Grav 37.8° @ 60°; TP 850 - 535; Shake out 1/4 of 1 1/2 BS & acid water. This test reflects 24 hour well capacity.
