Blinbry perfs. 5480-5624 swab & flow 53 Bbl. mud + 560 BLO + 28 BNO + 24 PAW + 130 BSW in 683 hrs. Gas rate 660 MCF/D. Shut in 96 hrs. Shut in on packer leakage test 72 hrs.
