DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On Aug. 24 the well was killed with oil and a Lane Wells bridge plug was set at 8042'. 4 sacks of cement was set on top of plug bringing plug back to 8018'. Casing was pressured to 2500 pounds and plug was holding. Well was perforated from 7951' to 7989' with four shots per foot and then treated with 2,000 gal. 15% acid. All oil used in treatment was recovered after which on 24-hour test ending 8:00 a.m. August 29, the well flowed 292 barrels of clean oil, no water.
