Gentlemen:

Concerning our recent discussion on the Elliott B-9 No. 3 located in Unit E of Section 9, T-22-S, R-37-E, this is to advise that the gas interval in this well is probably Drinkard, and your well would be classified as a gas well in the Drinkard Oil Pool. It is our opinion that the interval between the base of the Tubb Pool and the top of the Drinkard formation was left in a zone of no nomenclature for the purpose of preserving the gas cap on the top of the Drinkard.

Should you desire to apply for an NSP for a Tubb gas well, the matter would be set for a Hearing.
