FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Due to the decrease in production from the Ellenburger in this well, and the fact that it is no longer a commercial well in this zone, we propose to plug back to the Drinkard, and recomplate as follows:

Pull rods and tubing, and set wire line bridge plug at 6570'. Then perforate casing with four jet shots per foot from 6480' to 6535'. Then run tubing and set packer at 6450'. Swab tubing dry and acidize.
