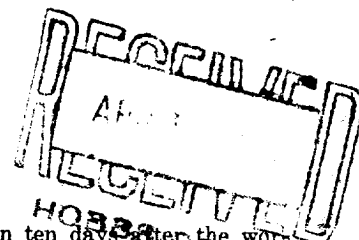

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

5205' Total depth, 7" O.D. 23# Casing set at 5205' and cemented with 300 Sax common and 50 Sax Incor. Went in hole with bit and found top of cement at 5139' and circulated for 3 hours, Tested Casing with 1200# for 30 Mins was OK. Gun Perforated with Lane Wells from 5115-5125' with 46 shots, Set 2" Tubing at 5070' with American Hookway Packer set at 5049', swabbed well 13 hours and getting ready to acidize with 2000 Gallons of Wester Acid. Well swabbed 18 barrels of water in 13 hours and swabbed dry.
