## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well was completed November 27, 1939, to produce from the Penrose-Skelly Zone, estimated oil production at time of completion 60 bbls. oil per day, present production 1 bbls. oil per day.

Following is a record of casing in well:

9-5/8" OD 36# Seamless Steel cemented at 1170' w/325 sax.  
7" OD 22# Seamless Steel cemented at 3578' w/275 sax.

The well will be cleaned out to bottom and a Caliper Survey will be made, and if necessary, the shot hole will be cemented. Rotary tools will be used to drill a 6-1/4" hole to an approximate depth of 8000' to test the Ellenberger lime. 5" OD casing will be set on bottom and perforated opposite the Ellenberger section.
