# DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

1776

## DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE

When in the Course of human events, it becomes necessary for one People to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume among the Powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the Laws of Nature and of Nature's God entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation.

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all Men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness.

That to secure these Rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed, -- That whenever any Form of Government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to institute new Government, laying its foundation on such Principles and organizing its Powers in such Form, as shall seem them most likely to effect their Safety and Happiness.

Prudence, indeed, will dictate that Governments long established should not be changed for light and transient Causes; and accordingly the People have suffered the most oppressive Acts of the British Ministry to be submitted to, until now.

But a long train of Abuses and Usurpations, growing out of the History of the United Colonies, and the repeated Petitions for Redress, have been answered only by repeated Injury.

History will record that the British Ministry have been the Authors of the following Abuses and Usurpations:

1. That the United Colonies have been taxed in a manner not warranted by the Consent of the People.

2. That the United Colonies have been subjected to a long Train of Abuses and Usurpations, growing out of the History of the United Colonies, and the repeated Petitions for Redress, have been answered only by repeated Injury.

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
