## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Acidized through casing perforations w/ 2000 gallons 15% acid. Max. pr.  
2100#, breaking back to 1900#. Flushed w/25 bbl. oil past displacement.  
After treatment, swabbed 8 hours, 105 bbl. load oil and acid water. Following  
day swabbed 135 bbl. load oil and acid water and well started flowing. On  
official test 9/2/50, flowed 95 barrels oil in 24 hours, 14/64" choke with  
GOR 2865/l. TP. 700, C.P. 880#.
