Re: Application for authority to dually complete Marathon Oil Company's L. Worthan, Well No. 4, located SW/4, NW/4, Sec. 11, T.22S, R.37E, Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

Marathon Oil Company respectfully requests that the Commission grant this application administratively for authority to dually complete Marathon Oil Company's L. Worthan, Well No. 4, for production of oil from the Paddock and Penrose-Skelly Pools. Attached hereto is the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission form, Application for Multiple Completion, fully executed, together with a diagrammatic sketch reflecting the manner in which Marathon proposes to complete the well, a plat indicating to the best of our knowledge the location of all wells on Marathon Oil Company's lease and all offset wells on offset leases and open hole and cased hole logs that were run during the initial completion and during current workover operations. Marathon Oil Company's L. Worthan, Well No. 4 is presently producing from the Paddock Pool and is located 1980 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line of Section 11, T.22S, R.37E.

A copy of this application, together with all attachments hereto, in conjunction with a waiver, is being mailed this date to each of the parties. The waiver includes a request that same should be forwarded to Santa Fe, New Mexico. The subject well will be completed and thereafter produced in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.
