

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Attempted packer seatings as follows in hole which had been acidized: 5126'; 5140'; 5148'; 5160'. Could not get packer to hold and shut water off.

Filled hole from 5210' to 5186' with pea gravel and from 5186' to 5170' with Calseal. Ran Securacoy $\frac{3}{4}$ " liner on tubing to depth of 5170' and squeezed with 50 sacks. Pulled tubing from hole and found liner had not unscrewed from tubing. Reran liner and set same at 5162'. Squeezed with 40 sacks then pulled tubing. Liner set O.K. Top liner @ 4875'
