FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This test has been drilled to a total depth of 4700'. We cemented 13-3/8" casing at 312' with 275 sacks and 8-5/8" casing at 2500' with 1800 sacks. The 8-5/8" casing collapsed at 1795' when total depth had been reached. The collapsed portion was swaged out and found to extend from 1795' to 1800'. A decision was reached to shut this test down and skid rig one location west and drill another test before completing it.

We pumped in a cement plug of 50 sacks above the collapsed portion of casing and spotted the bottom of plug at 1675'. The fill up was computed to be 3' per sack, or a total of 150'.
