Dear Randy:

I have before me your February 25th letter concerning our Hinton #4 in Unit I of Section 12, T-22-S, R-37-E. I apologize for the long delay in replying to your request for information concerning this well. When you first asked for it last summer, I gathered together a certain amount of the information and thought it had been sent to you; however, upon reviewing my records, I find that I had never completed the correspondence.

I have gone back through our files and find that on May 9, 1946 we filed with the Commission a Form C-103 with a letter attached setting forth in detail the work that was done on the Hinton #4. A copy of that form and the attachment are enclosed for your information. My records do not show that there was any remedial work done to the well subsequent to that time. It is noted on the form that the completion is shown in the Paddock Field although the perforations are shown from 5630-5670'. I believe that these perforations are in what we refer to now as the Blitebry Section and the statement on the Form C-103 was in error back in 1946.

We will of course be glad to file such forms that may be necessary to bring the Commission records up to date; however, before filing such forms, I felt it best to call this information to your attention and then await your decision concerning the filing of additional forms.
