Gentlemen:

A check of the files for your wells in the Blinebry Oil Pool shows that our records do not reflect a casinghead gas transporter for any of the following wells:

Hinton	No. 4-I	12-22-37
Hinton	No. 10-D	13-22-37
McAlester	No. 1-D	7-22-38
Rodgers	No. 2-H	12-22-37

If you do have a casinghead gas connection, please file Form C-110 showing the authorized transporter; if you are flaring gas from any of the wells it will be necessary for you to apply for No-Flare Orders for those wells to comply with the provisions of Commission Order R-610.

Further, although the Oil Proration Schedule carries the Hinton No. 4 in the Blinebry Oil Pool, our records still show it to be in the Paddock Pool. Please bring our file up to date by filing Form C-103 on the work-over and Form C-110 showing the correct pool designation.
