C Re; Application for 120 acre non-standard Gas Proration Unit, Blinebry Gas Pool, Comprising the S/2 of the SE/4 and the NW/4 of the SE/4 of Section 12, T-22-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

C Neville G. Penrose, Inc. hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the S/2 of the SE/4 and the NW/4 of the SE/4 of section 12, T-22-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico and in support thereof states the following facts:

P 1. Neville G. Penrose, Inc. is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as the Hinton Lease, Lea County, New Mexico.

2. Neville G. Penrose, Inc. proposes that the above described acreage be established as a non-standard 120 acre gas proration unit in exception to Rule 5 of Order R-610.

Y 3. The Hinton #5 well, located 990' from the south line and 990' from the east line of section 12, was completed as a Tubbs gas well on December 30, 1953 and dually completed in the Blinebry gas zone on December 26, 1957. This application is for a non-standard proration unit on the Blinebry gas zone.

4. The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5 of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-610 as follows:

a. Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.

b. The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.

c. All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.

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
