FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We cemented 5 1/2" fifteen and one-half pound casing at 5179' with 600 sacks. Plug was pumped down at 8:30 P.M. June 17, 1946. Total depth of hole is 5180'. We propose to allow cement 48 hours set time then drill cement to depth of approximately 5175' and run Lane Wells Electric Log. After correlating the electric log with sample analysis we will perforate casing opposite the pay sections; run tubing and swab well in. If acid treatment is necessary to produce a flow, such will be given the well.
