DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

5 1/2" casing was cemented at 5179' with 600 sacks. Cement was allowed 72 hours set time then casing was entered with tubing and cement drilled out to depth of 5170'. Casing was pressure tested and found to be O.K. Mud was circulated out by displacing with water and casing was gun-perforated from 5170' to 5140' with 4 shots per foot.
