## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

5 1/2" (15 1/2#) casing was cemented at 5206' with 200 sacks on Sept. 14, 1946. Plug was pumped down at 7:30 P.M. Cement was allowed approximately 65 hours set time before being drilled. Casing was pressure tested with 1800# and showed to be O.K.
