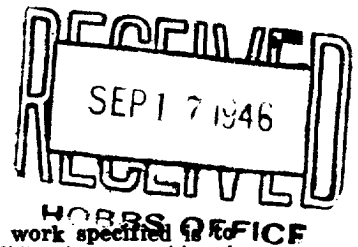

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We cemented a string of 152# 5 1/2" casing at 5206' with 200 sacks on September 14, 1946. Plug was pumped down at 7:30 P.M.

We propose to drill cement on the morning of September 17, 1946 and pressure test casing. We then plan to deepen the hole to a depth of approximately 5221', run tubing and swab well in for a natural test.
