

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We wish to modify, as follows, the casing program submitted with our notice of intention to drill, given under date of April 30, 1946:

Instead of cementing 8-5/8" casing at 1200' and 5-1/2" casing at 5200' we wish to cement 48# 13-1/2" casing at 150 feet with 150 sacks; cement 36# 9-5/8" casing at approximately 2850' with 1500 sacks and cement 23# 7" casing at 5200' with 350 sacks if tests indicate commercial production at this depth. If such production is not indicated, the well will be drilled deeper and casing will be cemented through any commercial production which may be encountered and then will be gun-perforated opposite such pay.
