## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We have drilled this test to a depth of 5705'. We reduced hole from 8-3/4" to 6-1/4" at 5620'. In order to test properly the section from 5620' to 5705' we have cemented a string of 7" casing on the shoulder at 5620' with 175 sacks. Plug was pumped down at 8:15 P.M. January 17, 1949. We propose to allow cement a set time of 60 hours, then pick up tubing and drill plug, after pressure testing casing for proof of satisfactory cement job. We will then wash hole to bottom and test the formation in open hole.
